I. General information

The 46th International Race Walking Festival - Alytus'2020 will take place on Friday, 18 September in Alytus City .

Alytus is the centre of the culture, sport and industry of the South Lithuania. The distance between Alytus and Vilnius (capital of Lithuania) is 100 km, the distance between Alytus and Kaunas is 75 km, between Alytus and Hrodna (BLR) and between Alytus and Augustow (POL) - 100 km.

Alytus has received the city rights based on the Magdeburg Law in 1581.

The population of Alytus is approximately 51,000 people.
