WALKER OF THE WEEK



She's at it again. **Phoebe Chadwick (QLD)** is obviously developing a taste for WOTW gongs. Not content with winning last week with two big PBs, Phoebe showed that her present good form is no flash in the pan with an enormous 2:11 improvement in the QA 5000m championships at the University of QLD track last Saturday night, crossing in **26:14.84**. For good measure, Phoebe also reduced her 3000m best (set the previous week) by 11 secs *en route*.

Sharing the award with Phoebe this time around is her QRWC clubmate, **Lachlan Moore (14yo)**. Also competing at the QA 5000m championships, Lachlan sliced nearly a minute from his PB to blast through the 25-min barrier in clocking **24:28.90**. One of a stream of lads from the Sunshine state – among them Noah Cooke, Koby Irvine and Hayden Robertson – who are climbing towards the top in the national rankings, Lachlan has built his racing fitness mainly over 3km/3000m with

only occasional forays into the 5000m. It's an approach that has paid off, with Saturday's result showing his ability to extend his speed over the extra 2km without difficulty. We can expect to see Lachlan in action at the national All Schools at Lakeside in December, and on this form he looks headed for a big result.

Well done, Phoebe and Lachlan. It'll be great to follow your progress over the coming months.

*Honourable mention

 Olivia Boulton (QLD) – another big improver in the QA 5000m, just missing the 26:00 barrier by .04 of a sec for a 27 sec PB.


