Such was the case in Adelaide's City to Bay running events on Sunday 15 September, where **Kim Mottrom (SA)** race-walked the 21.1km half-marathon distance in **1:41:16** – a time that surely left a good many club runners in his wake and, over double the distance, would have seen him walk a sub-3:30 marathon. He likely had the fitness for it!

Kim's time indicates that he went through 20km in around 1:36-1:37 ... a creditable effort on surfaces that would have been very unlike the even flatness of South Parklands, while negotiating his way around slowing runners (no doubt some dressed as SpongeBob, Kim?) Not to mention the tram tracks on Jetty Rd.

Well done, Kim. After another strong winter, you're set up for another summer of fast track times.





Athletics Victoria has announced the schedule of the 2024-25 AVSL track & field season. There are 10 rounds (no finals or playoffs), with the club leading in each grade at the end of Round 10 to be declared Premiers for the season.

It's pleasing to see that walks are provided in all 10 rounds, with the four regular race distances (1500m, 2000m, 3000m and 5000m) scheduled in five rounds each.



INTERNATIONAL NEWS

LITHUANIA: International Race Walking Festival Alytus, 20 September - Alytus

The 50th edition of this annual celebration saw the visiting Ukrainians well in command in the Open division, as well as providing the U20 male winner. The following report is from *O Marchador*:

Ukrainian race walkers dominate 50th edition of Alytus, Lithuania

This time on the track of the Municipal Stadium of Alytus, a Lithuanian city that hosted the European Race Walking Cup in 2019, the 50th edition of the International Race Walking Festival took place last Friday (20/9), an event that had as absolute winners of the 10,000 meters (mixed event), the Ukrainians Serhiy Svitlychnyi and Lyudmila Olyanovska.

In the men's event, with the top three finishers breaking the 40-minute barrier and achieving personal bests, **Serhiy Svitlychnyi** stood out to win in **39:12.33**, ahead of his 20-year-old compatriot **Mykola Rushchak** in **39:52.40** and Latvian **Raivo Saulgriezis** in **39:56.49**. The top under-20 finisher (6th overall) was another Ukrainian, **Eduard Muravskyi**, in **43:48.19**. Fourteen athletes took part.

In the women's event, with 12 athletes lining up at the start, **Lyudmila Olyanovska** triumphed with a significant advantage, recording a time of **42:25.77** at the finish line, a time that places her third in the world rankings for the year. In the immediate places were her compatriots **Mariia Sakharuk**, with **43:25.43**, a personal best of **Hanna Shevchuk**, with **45:18.85**, and **Valeriya Sholomitska**, with **46:00.21**. Reference for the Lithuanian victory in the under-20 category through **Justė Perveneckaitė**, 18, from Švenčionys, with a personal best of **47:20.92**.

Racewalking Coaches Wanted

Club coach **Mark Donahoo** is currently working with Athletics Victoria and Athletics Australia to develop a **Level 1 Racewalking course** for coaches and non-coaches.

The course would be held in Melbourne and would probably be a half-day course which would include both theory and practical elements.

The course would cover the areas of:

- Racewalking Rule
- · Racewalking technique
- · Exercises for racewalkers
- Setting basic programs for walkers of all ages, including peaking and rest phases.
- Training techniques
- Other topics may be included

As a beginning for to this process, Mark is asking for anyone who is interested in attending a racewalk coaching course to contact him via email. The email does not lock anyone into doing the course but is to be used as a way of finding out if there is much interest in the course. There is no date or time set for a course vet.

Spread the word amongst those who are racewalking. The more interest shown, the better the opportunity will be to conduct this course.
